## AFTERNOON TEA

A Great British Tradition served 12.00 – 6.00pm

*Tea, the Most Quintessential of English Drinks, is a relative latecomer to British shores. Although the customs of drinking tea dates back to the third millennium BC in China, it was not until the mid-17th century that tea first appeared.*

*Afternoon tea was introduced in England by Anna, the seventh Duchess of Bedford, in the year 1840. The Duchess would become hungry around 4 o' clock in the afternoon. The evening meal in the household was served fashionably late at eight o'clock, thus leaving a long period of time between lunch and dinner.*

*The Duchess asked that a tray of tea, bread and butter and a cake be brought to her room during the late afternoon. This became a habit and she began inviting her friends to join her. The pause for tea became a fashionable social event. During the 1880's upper-class and Society women would change into long gowns, gloves and hats for their afternoon tea which was usually served in the drawing room between four and five o' clock.*
